BECOME A LIFEGUARD & WATER SAFETY INSTRUCTOR



Become skilled in teamwork, leadership, communication and customer service!

Overview: This specialized work focuses on protecting and monitoring the City of St. Petersburg's public pools. You will be responsible for the safety of visitors at the facility, and you must be able to communicate clearly, provide customer service and adhere to professional standards.

Water Safety Instructor Responsibilities:

- Instruct classes
- Assist with maintaining pool, facilities and equipment

Water Safety Instructor Qualifications:

- Successful completion of American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Training.

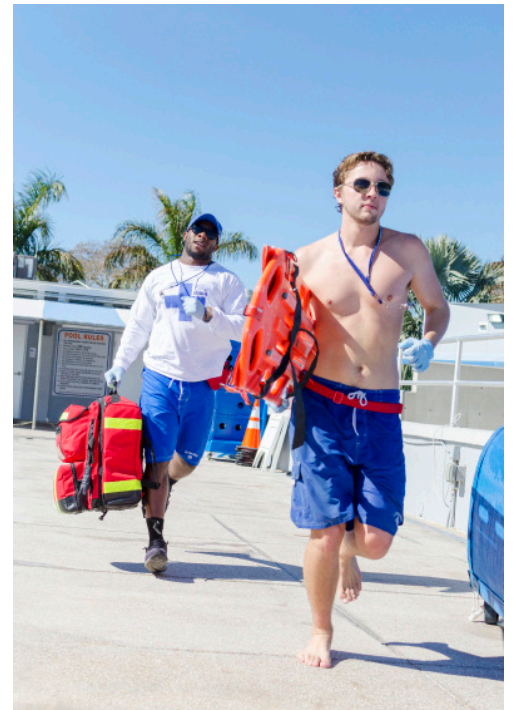
**Most positions require you to have both Water Safety Instructor and Lifeguard certifications.*

Lifeguard Responsibilities:

- Monitor swimmers in and around facility
- Rescue and administer, as needed, first aid or CPR to facility patrons.
- Assist with maintaining pool, facilities and equipment

Lifeguard Qualifications:

- Successful completion of American Red Cross Lifeguard course, which includes CPR for Professional Rescuer and First Aid training.

Prerequisites: Must pass a required swim test prior to registering for classes, and must be 15 years old by the time classes conclude (proof of age required). *Swim test offered at North Shore Aquatic Complex by appointment.*

Registration: Register in person at North Shore Aquatic Complex. Contact 727-893-7727 for more information.

Fee: \$160 pool fee (includes \$36 Red Cross fee).

Fee: \$110 pool fee and \$36 Red Cross fee due at registration.
