- **Valid Driver License or State ID** - For minor participants, the Driver License or State ID of a parent or legal guardian.
- **Completed Hold Harmless Agreement** - Form may be obtained in advance by visiting www.stpeteparksrec.org.
- **Participant Photo** - Photo will be taken by Parks and Recreation personnel if a membership card is requested.

Before School, After School, and Summer Camp - Fees are adjusted for families who qualify for fee assistance, see office staff for details on eligibility. Parents must provide proof of status upon registration. Elementary school transportation is for children registered in Before School or After School only.

Free Before School and After School Teen Camp - See office staff for details on qualifying for our free teen programs. Proof of income must be provided. Middle school transportation is for children registered in Before School or After School only.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE? - Children must be six (6) years old on or before September 1, of this year. Children entering grades 1 through 6 are eligible for Playcamp and those entering grades 7 through 9 are eligible for Teen Camp.

DATES - May 29 - August 10, 2018, **HOURS** - 7:30 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. (Extended care from 7:00 - 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 - 6:00 p.m. is available for \$52 per child per time slot for the summer.)

FEES - Fees for Summer Playcamp and Teen Camp programs are as follows:

- Playcamp - Full \$762 Reduced \$647.70 Free \$257.95
- Teen Camp - Full \$806 Reduced \$685.10 Free \$282.10

A \$25 nonrefundable deposit is required per child. Payment plans are available for an additional fee of \$15. Any past due payments will result in a \$10 late fee. Fee assistance is available for City residents who receive Free or Reduced lunch at school. Documentation from the school verifying Free or Reduced lunch must be presented at time of registration.

WHEN IS REGISTRATION?

OPEN REGISTRATION - City residents and nonresidents can register at any time beginning May 1, 2018 for Summer Camp (full summer only). Full payment accepted or see payment plans.

WEEKLY REGISTRATION - City residents and nonresidents can register at any time beginning May 8, 2018 for Weekly Summer Camp. The Playcamp fee is \$85 per week, and the Teen Camp fee is \$90 per week.

WHAT IS NEEDED TO REGISTER? - Two proofs of residency (Voter's ID, Driver License, deed or lease agreement, tax statement, or water bill), completed registration forms, and payment (cash, credit card, debit card, money order or check made out to the City of St. Petersburg) are required for registration.

DO PARENTS NEED TO BE PRESENT TO REGISTER? - We strongly suggest that a parent be present; however, he/she may complete the paperwork and have another adult (who is not registering another child) make the payment as long as proof of residency of parent is provided.

BREAKFAST AND LUNCH - A nutritionally balanced breakfast and lunch are provided daily by the USDA Summer Food Service Program. Children may choose to bring their own nonrefrigerated lunch. Please send snack or snack money.
