All participants must show their Driver License or State ID, complete a Hold Harmless Agreement, and have their picture taken at the front office the first time in attendance and subsequently every September. Additionally, all participants must sign in at the front desk when in attendance.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE? - Children must be six (6) years old on or before September 1, of this year. Children entering grades 1 through 6 are eligible for Playcamp and those entering grades 7 through 9 are eligible for Teen Camp.

DATES - May 30 - August 4, 2017, **HOURS** - 7:30 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. (Extended care from 7:00 - 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 - 6:00 p.m. is available for \$52 per child per time slot for the 8-week summer.)

FEES - Fees for 10-week Summer Playcamp and Teen Camp programs are as follows:

Playcamp - Full \$695.00 Reduced \$590.75 Free \$243.25
Teen Camp - Full \$735.00 Reduced \$624.75 Free \$257.25

A \$25 nonrefundable deposit is required per child. Payment plans are available for an additional fee of \$15. Any past due payments will result in a \$10 late fee. Fee assistance is available for City residents who receive Free or Reduced lunch at school. Documentation from the school verifying Free or Reduced lunch must be presented at time of registration.

WHEN IS REGISTRATION?

OPEN REGISTRATION - City residents and nonresidents can register at any time beginning May 1, 2017 for Summer Camp 2017 (full summer only). Full payment accepted or see payment plans.

WEEKLY REGISTRATION - City residents and nonresidents can register at any time beginning May 8, 2017 for Weekly Summer Camp 2017. The Playcamp fee is \$85 per week, and the Teen Camp fee is \$90 per week.

WHAT IS NEEDED TO REGISTER? - Two proofs of residency (Voter's ID, Driver License, deed or lease agreement, tax statement, or water bill), completed registration forms, and payment (cash, credit card, debit card, money order or check made out to the City of St. Petersburg) are required for registration.

DO PARENTS NEED TO BE PRESENT TO REGISTER? - We strongly suggest that a parent be present; however, he/she may complete the paperwork and have another adult (who is not registering another child) make the payment as long as proof of residency of parent is provided.

BREAKFAST AND LUNCH - A nutritionally balanced breakfast and lunch are provided daily by the USDA Summer Food Service Program. Children may choose to bring their own nonrefrigerated lunch. Please send snack or snack money.
