Thank you for your interest in the Azalea Community Garden. The Community Garden Coordinator has the authority and right to terminate the permissive use of the garden box at any time for just cause. Just cause includes neglect of the garden to the extent that the box becomes a source of weeds that affects other boxes. Should this guideline be disregarded, the gardener will be sent a letter informing him that he/she has ten (10) days to correct the problem. If not corrected in the time stipulated, garden privileges will be revoked with no refunds.

Availability

Garden boxes rent for six month periods beginning September 1 and March 1.

Payment

Payment may be made by cash, check (made payable to City of St. Petersburg), or credit card.

Additional Information

- **Non-Renewal** - If not renewing the rental, it is the responsibility of the gardener to leave the box clean and free of vegetation. The gardener should inform the coordinator at (727) 893-7150 when the garden has been cleaned and vacated. The gate key issued must be returned. This should occur prior to the end of the months of February and/or August.
- **Security** - Please keep the garden equipment secured with the lock when not in use. Please lock the garden gates when leaving the garden.
- **Watering** - Water from the wells should be used only for watering the community garden boxes. Please make certain the water is turned off before leaving.
- **Irrigation** - No modification or addition to the irrigation system, such as sprinklers, drip lines or soaker hoses, is allowed.
- **Pesticides** - No pesticides or herbicides are to be used unless clearance is given by the Community Garden Coordinator. It is recommended to use vinegar as a weed deterrent.
- **Paths** - Do not leave anything in the aisles as it may restrict others' access to their boxes.
- **Pruning** - Keep plants confined to the boxes. We reserve the right to cut away growth which extends over the sides of the boxes.
- **Trash** - Dispose of trash in designated areas. Do not leave trash in aisles. Place pulled vegetation in the compost bins located within the fence. Leave non-vegetation items in trash bins outside of the garden and it will be removed.
- **Trees/Shrubbery** - Trees and shrubbery are not allowed as they may restrict other boxes from available sun.
- **Other Structures** - No structure that restricts the sun on another box is allowed.
- **Personal Property** - Please do not leave personal property in the garden. The City is not responsible for personal items left at the gardens.
- **Please respect the rights of others.** Please show consideration for the privacy and property of the neighbors living adjacent to the garden.
