Herpetology (Ages 7-11)

Explore the fascinating world of reptiles and amphibians! Encounters with gopher tortoises, frogs, lizards and snakes help campers learn about the ecology and conservation of these important animals.

Magical Beasts (Ages 7-12 & 13-17)

Enter into the magical world of nature. Campers will explore the lore and history of ecology and botany, and they'll take home a magical craft each day.

Nature Adventure (Ages 7-13)

Campers learn about Florida's habitats and its inhabitants, get dirty during dip-netting, observe wildlife while hiking preserve trails and acquire basic birding skills. Every day includes natural history topics and exciting adventures, crafts and activities.

Pioneer Camp (Ages 7-13)

Campers experience a time when family, friendship and character were as important as food, water and shelter. Young pioneers learn, through activities adapted from the Association for Experiential Education, to foster team building, leadership and self-esteem.

Raptor Camp (Ages 8-12)

Campers have up-close encounters with live birds of prey including owls, hawks, vultures and a bald eagle. Learn the important role these apex predators play in the environment as well as how to care for and train them.

Sprouts (Ages 3-4)

A camp filled with songs, stories, games and nature walks! Campers enjoy habitat investigations and activities that will demonstrate our connection to nature. Children must be potty trained.



Wild Explorers (Ages 5-7 & 7-11)

Campers learn about wildlife, the interdependence of all living things and concepts of conservation through hands-on exploration, interactive games, hikes, crafts and songs designed to nurture the love of the great outdoors.

Wildlife Ecology (Ages 7-11)

Campers will explore the ecology and conservation of Florida's wildlife and wildlands through hands-on activities, guest presentations and exploration of the preserve's diverse habitats where campers will practice their nature detective skills.

Young Naturalist (Ages 5-6)

Explore the natural world, exercise personal creativity and learn to share discoveries by working together and having fun. New theme each week.
