### TASCO AFTER-SCHOOL TECHNOLOGY PROGRAMS

TASCO offers free after-school technology programs for teens in grades 6 through 12. These courses are designed to introduce teens to different media techniques and then progress to hands-on learning experiences. Classes are held in the areas of Photography, Graphic Arts, Video Production, Audio and Computers. Participants use DSLR cameras, professional video cameras, and computers loaded with the latest software. Our state of the art facility has a computer lab, television studio, and digital editing suites. Our programs are fun, value based programs, so teens want to be involved.

### TASCO HOME SCHOOL TECHNOLOGY PROGRAMS

From September through May TASCO offers home school classes during the day. Most classes are held on Tuesdays, and a morning and afternoon session is offered. There is a minimal fee for the classes and a free Advantage card must be issued to participate. Classes are 10 weeks per session. Please call us or check our website for a current class listing.

## TASCO SUMMER TEEN TECHNOLOGY CAMP

This program is a 10 week, Monday through Friday camp for teens entering grades 7 through 10. It is designed to teach teens Television and Video Production, How to build your own Computer, Digital Audio and DJing, and Digital Photography/Graphic Arts. Participants leave the program with an intermediate/advanced education in the Media field. Although this is a learning/specialty camp, it is also a fun camp. Thursdays are dedicated to attending the TASCO Summer Extreme events and Fridays are used for field trips and guest speakers related to subject matter the teens are learning at that time.

## TASCO OVERLAY TECHNOLOGY PROGRAMS

During the school year and summer, classes are provided off-site at various outside youth development agencies including R Club, Boys and Girls Club, YMCA, Youth Arts Corps, Lifeforce, and 21<sup>st</sup> Century Learning Centers. These classes are 8 week, 1 hour classes to introduce middle school teens to technology programs. Areas taught are video, audio, photography & Photoshop, and computer building.
